

Attention Paraglider Pilots

Welcome to Mount Jumbo!

Important Site Information and Protocol:

- 1) Call the Missoula Air Traffic Control Tower from the trailhead. **(406)549-2979**. Tell them you will be flying Mt. Jumbo, the number of pilots, approximate launch time. Be polite and brief when speaking with the tower personnel—they are busy. If the tower personnel have any questions or concerns, please direct them to Derek Goldman, USHPA PG observer, (406) 370-6491.
- 2) Call the tower again at the conclusion of the flying session.
- 3) Be a current USHPA member.
- 4) Pilots new to the site must fly with a local pilot before going solo.
- 5) P-2 (novice) pilots must fly 5 flights with 2 different pilots who have flown the site for at least a season.
- 6) Avoid the Class D airspace that begins approximately 1 mile west of Mt. Jumbo. Stay alert for the occasional low-flying aircraft, especially inbound from the east.
- 7) Avoid disturbing deer or elk when flying.
- 8) Check for postings of mid-to-late-summer fire restrictions that often close the mountain.
- 9) Fly within the recommended operating limitations for your rating; pay attention to changing conditions....
